A BYLAW TO AMEND

That Bylaw No. 4(2007) Being a Bylaw of The Town of Bienfait, Province of Saskatchewan, a Bylaw Respecting the Construction of Residential Swimming Pools and Prescribing Regulations Governing the Use of Residential Swimming Pools Thereto is amended by adding the following Section 3 "new section" after Section 2, Subsection b. xi

- a. Every application for a permit to construct a residential swimming pool shall be in Form A, and shall be accompanied by two sets of the plans and specifications of the proposed swimming pool.
 - b. If the work described in an application for a residential swimming pool permit, to the best of the knowledge of the local authority or its authorized representative, complies with the requirements of this bylaw, the local authority, upon receipt of the prescribed fee, shall issue a permit in Form B and return one set of submitted plans to the applicant.
 - Every application for a residential swimming pool permit is subject to a fee of \$10.00
